

¹So these three men ceased to answer Job, because he was righteous in his own eyes.²Then was kindled the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled, because he justified himself rather than God.³Also against his three friends was his wrath kindled, because they had found no answer, and yet had condemned Job.⁴Now Elihu had waited till Job had spoken, because they were elder than he.⁵When Elihu saw that there was no answer in the mouth of these three men, then his wrath was kindled.⁶And Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite answered and said, I am young, and ye are very old; wherefore I was afraid, and durst not shew you mine opinion.⁷I said, Days should speak, and multitude of years should teach wisdom.⁸But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them understanding.⁹Great men are not always wise: neither do the aged understand judgment.¹⁰Therefore I said, Harken to me; I also will shew mine opinion.¹¹Behold, I waited for your words; I gave ear to your reasons, whilst ye searched out what to say.¹²Yea, I attended unto you, and, behold, there was none of you that convinced Job, or that answered his words:¹³Lest ye should say, We have found out wisdom: God thrusteth him down, not man.¹⁴Now he hath not directed his words against me: neither will I answer him with your speeches.¹⁵They were amazed, they answered no more: they left off speaking.¹⁶When I had waited, (for they spake not, but stood still, and answered no more;)¹⁷I said, I will answer also my part, I
