

¹A Psalm for Solomon. Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.² He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment.³ The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness.⁴ He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor.⁵ They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations.⁶ He shall come down like rain upon the mown grass: as showers that water the earth.⁷ In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth.⁸ He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth.⁹ They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before him; and his enemies shall lick the dust.¹⁰ The kings of Tarshish and of the isles shall bring presents: the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts.¹¹ Yea, all kings shall fall down before him: all nations shall serve him.¹² For he shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and him that hath no helper.¹³ He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.¹⁴ He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.¹⁵ And he shall live, and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba: prayer also shall be made for him continually; and daily shall he be praised.¹⁶ There shall be an handful of corn in the earth upon the top of the mountains; the fruit thereof shall shake like Lebanon: and they of the city shall flourish like grass
