

¹In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.² And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.³ And it shall come to pass, that when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say unto him, Thou shalt not live; for thou speakest lies in the name of the LORD: and his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he prophesieth.⁴ And it shall come to pass in that day, that the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to deceive:⁵ But he shall say, I am no prophet, I am an husbandman; for man taught me to keep cattle from my youth.⁶ And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.⁷ Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.⁸ And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the LORD, two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left therein.⁹ And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall

¹فِي ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمِ يَكُونُ بَيْتُ دَاوُدَ وَلِسْكَانِ أُورُشَلِيمَ لِلْخَطِيئَةِ وَلِلنَّجَاسَةِ.² وَيَكُونُ فِي ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمِ، يَقُولُ رَبُّ الْجُنُودِ، أَنِّي أَقْطَعُ أَسْمَاءَ الْأَصْنَامِ مِنَ الْأَرْضِ فَلَا تُذَكَّرُ بَعْدُ، وَأَزِيلُ الْأَنْبِيَاءَ أَيْضًا وَالرُّوحَ النَّجِسَ مِنَ الْأَرْضِ.³ وَيَكُونُ إِذَا تَنَبَّأَ أَحَدٌ بَعْدُ أَنَّ أَبَاهُ وَأُمَّهُ وَالِدَيْهِ يَقُولَانِ لَهُ، لَا تَعِيشُ لَأَنَّكَ تَكَلَّمْتَ بِالْكَذِبِ بِاسْمِ الرَّبِّ. فَيَقْطَعُهُ أَبُوهُ وَأُمُّهُ وَإِلِدَاهُ عِنْدَمَا يَتَنَبَّأُ.⁴ وَيَكُونُ فِي ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمِ أَنَّ الْأَنْبِيَاءَ يَحْزَنُونَ كُلُّ وَاحِدٍ مِنْ رُؤْيَاهُ إِذَا تَنَبَّأَ، وَلَا يَلْبِسُونَ ثَوْبَ شَعْرِ لِأَجْلِ الْغَشِّ.⁵ بَلْ يَقُولُ، لَسْتُ أَنَا نَبِيًّا. أَنَا إِنْسَانٌ قَالِحُ الْأَرْضِ، لِأَنَّ إِنْسَانًا أَفْتَنَانِي مِنْ صِبَايَ.⁶ فَيَسْأَلُهُ، مَا هَذِهِ الْجُرُوحُ فِي يَدَيْكَ. فَيَقُولُ، هِيَ الَّتِي جُرِحْتُ بِهَا فِي بَيْتِ أَجْبَانِي.⁷ اسْتَيْقِظْ يَا سَيْفُ عَلَى رَاعِيٍّ وَعَلَى رَجُلٍ رَفَقْتَنِي، يَقُولُ رَبُّ الْجُنُودِ. اضْرِبِ الرَّاعِيَّ فَتَسْقُطَ الْعَنَمُ، وَأَرْذُلُ يَدَيَّ عَلَى الصَّغَارِ.⁸ وَيَكُونُ فِي كُلِّ الْأَرْضِ يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ أَنِّي ثَلَاثِينَ مِنْهَا يُقْطَعَانِ وَيَمُوتَانِ، وَالثَّلَاثُ يَبْقَى فِيهَا.⁹ وَأَذِلُّ الثَّلَاثَ فِي النَّارِ، وَأَمْحِصُهُمْ كَمْحَصِ الْفِصَّةِ، وَأَمْحِجُهُمْ أَمْحِجَانَ الذَّهَبِ. هُوَ يَدْعُو بِاسْمِي وَأَنَا أَجِيبُهُ. أَقُولُ، هُوَ سَعْيِي وَهُوَ يَقُولُ، الرَّبُّ إِلَهِي.
