 مُرْسِلُكَ إِلَيْهِمْ. فَتَقُولُ لَهُمْ، هَكَذَا قَالَ السَّيِّدُ
 الرَّبُّ.⁵وَهُمْ إِنْ سَمِعُوا وَإِنْ امْتَنَعُوا لِأَنَّهُمْ بَيْتٌ مُتَمَرِّدٌ
 فَإِنَّهُمْ يَعْلَمُونَ أَنَّ بَيْتًا كَانَ بَيْنَهُمْ.⁶أَمَّا أَنْتَ يَا ابْنَ آدَمَ فَلَا
 تَحْزَنُ مِنْهُمْ، وَمِنْ كَلَامِهِمْ لَا تَحْزَنُ، لِأَنَّهُمْ قَرِيسٌ وَسُلَاءٌ
 لَدَيْكَ، وَأَنْتَ سَاكِنٌ بَيْنَ الْعَقَارِ. مِنْ كَلَامِهِمْ لَا تَحْزَنُ
 وَمِنْ وَجْهِهِمْ لَا تَرْتَعِبُ، لِأَنَّهُمْ بَيْتٌ مُتَمَرِّدٌ.⁷وَتَتَكَلَّمُ
 مَعَهُمْ بِكَلَامِي إِنْ سَمِعُوا وَإِنْ امْتَنَعُوا، لِأَنَّهُمْ
 مُتَمَرِّدُونَ.⁸وَأَنْتَ يَا ابْنَ آدَمَ فَاسْمَعْ مَا أَنَا مُكَلِّمُكَ بِهِ. لَا
 تَكُنْ مُتَمَرِّدًا كَالْبَيْتِ الْمُتَمَرِّدِ. افْتَحْ فَمَكَ وَكُلْ مَا أَنَا
 مُعْطِيكَ.⁹فَتَطْرُقُ وَإِذَا بِيَدٍ مَمْدُودَةٍ إِلَيَّ، وَإِذَا بِدَرَجٍ سَفَرٍ
 فِيهَا.¹⁰فَتَسْرَهُ أَمَامِي وَهُوَ مَكْتُوبٌ مِنْ دَاخِلٍ وَمِنْ قَعَاءِ
 وَكُتِبَ فِيهِ مَرَاتٍ وَنَحِيبٌ وَوَيْلٌ.
