

¹ يَا رَبُّ، أَنْتَ إِلَهِي أُعْظِمُكَ. أَحْمَدُ اسْمَكَ لِأَنَّكَ صَنَعْتَ عَجَبًا. مَقاصِدُكَ مُنْذُ الْقَدِيمِ أَمَانَةٌ وَصِدْقٌ. ² لِأَنَّكَ جَعَلْتَ مَدِينَةَ رُحْمَةَ. قَرْيَةَ حَصِينَةَ رَدْمًا. قَصَرَ أَعَاجِمَ أَنْ لَا تَكُونَ مَدِينَةً. لَا يَبْنَى إِلَى الْأَبَدِ. ³ لِذَلِكَ يُكْرِمُكَ شَعْبٌ قَوِيٌّ، وَتَخَافُ مِنْكَ قَرْيَةُ أَمَمٍ عَتَاةٍ. ⁴ لِأَنَّكَ كُنْتَ جِصْنًا لِلْمَيْسِكِينَ، جِصْنًا لِلْبَانِسِ فِي ضَيْقِهِ، مَلَجًا مِنَ السَّيْلِ، ظِلًّا مِنَ الْحَرِّ، إِذْ كَانَتْ تَفْحَةُ الْعُتَاةِ كَسِيلٍ عَلَى خَانِطٍ. ⁵ كَحَرٍّ فِي يَبَسٍ تَخْفِضُ صَجِيجَ الْأَعَاجِمِ. كَحَرٍّ يَطْلُ عَيْمٌ بُذِلَ عَتَاءُ الْعَتَاةِ. ⁶ وَيَصْنَعُ رَبُّ الْجُنُودِ لَجَمِيعِ الشُّعُوبِ فِي هَذَا الْجَبَلِ وَلِيَمَّةَ سَمَائِنَ، وَلِيَمَّةَ حَمْرِ عَلَى دُرْدِيٍّ، سَمَائِنَ مُمَحَّةً، دُرْدِيٍّ مُصَفَّى. ⁷ وَيُقْنِي فِي هَذَا الْجَبَلِ وَجَّةَ الثَّقَابِ الَّذِي عَلَى كُلِّ الشُّعُوبِ، وَالْإِعْطَاءَ الْمُعْطَى بِهِ عَلَى كُلِّ الْأَمَمِ. ⁸ يَبْلُغُ الْمَوْتَ إِلَى الْأَبَدِ، وَيَمْسَحُ السَّيِّدُ الرَّبُّ الدَّمُوعَ عَنْ كُلِّ الْوُجُوهِ، وَيَنْزِعُ غَارَ شَعْبِهِ عَنْ كُلِّ الْأَرْضِ، لِأَنَّ الرَّبَّ قَدْ تَكَلَّمَ. ⁹ وَيُقَالُ فِي ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمِ، هُوَذَا هَذَا إِلَهُنَا. انْتَهَرَنَاهُ فَحَلَصْنَا. هَذَا هُوَ الرَّبُّ انْتَهَرَنَاهُ. تَبْتَهِّجُ وَتَفْرَحُ بِخَلَاصِهِ. ¹⁰ لِأَنَّ يَدَ الرَّبِّ تَسْتَقِرُّ عَلَى هَذَا الْجَبَلِ، وَيُدَاسُ مُوَابُ فِي مَكَانِهِ كَمَا يُدَاسُ الثَّنْبُ فِي مَاءِ الْمَرْبَلَةِ. ¹¹ فَيَبْسُطُ يَدَيْهِ فِيهِ كَمَا يَبْسُطُ السَّابِغُ لِيَسْبِغَ، فَيَصْعُ كِبْرِيَاءَهُ مَعَ مَكَايِدِ يَدَيْهِ. ¹² وَصَرَاحُ اِزْتِفَاعِ أَسْوَارِكَ بِخَفِصَتِهِ. يَصْعُقُهُ، يُلْصِقُهُ بِالْأَرْضِ إِلَى الثَّرَابِ.

¹ O LORD, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are faithfulness and truth. ² For thou hast made of a city an heap; of a defenced city a ruin: a palace of strangers to be no city; it shall never be built. ³ Therefore shall the strong people glorify thee, the city of the terrible nations shall fear thee. ⁴ For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall. ⁵ Thou shalt bring down the noise of strangers, as the heat in a dry place; even the heat with the shadow of a cloud: the branch of the terrible ones shall be brought low. ⁶ And in this mountain shall the LORD of hosts make unto all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined. ⁷ And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the vail that is spread over all nations. ⁸ He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken it. ⁹ And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation. ¹⁰ For in this mountain shall the hand of the LORD rest, and Moab shall be trodden down under him, even as straw is trodden down for the dunghill. ¹¹ And he shall spread forth his

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hands in the midst of them, as he that
swimmeth spreadeth forth his hands to
swim: and he shall bring down their pride
together with the spoils of their
hands.¹² And the fortress of the high fort of
thy walls shall he bring down, lay low, and
bring to the ground, even to the dust.
