⁵وَمَتَى صَلَّيْتَ فَلَا تَكُنْ كَالْمُرَائِينَ، فَإِنَّهُمْ يُجْشُونَ أَنْ يُصَلُّوا قَائِمِينَ فِي الْمَجَامِعِ وَفِي رَوَابِ السَّوَارِعِ لِكَيْ يَظْهَرُوا لِلنَّاسِ، الْحَقُّ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ: إِنَّهُمْ قَدْ اسْتَوْفَوْا أَجْرَهُمْ. ⁶وَأَمَّا أَنْتَ فَمَتَى صَلَّيْتَ فَادْخُلْ إِلَى مَخْدَعِكَ وَأَغْلِقْ بَابَكَ وَصَلِّ إِلَى أَبِيكَ الَّذِي فِي الْخَفَاءِ، فَأَبُوكَ الَّذِي بَرَى فِي الْخَفَاءِ يُجَارِيكَ عِلَاقِيَّةً. ⁷وَجَبِينَا نُصَلُّونَ لَا تُكْزِّرُوا الْكَلَامَ بَاطِلًا كَالْأَمَمِ، فَإِنَّهُمْ يَظُنُّونَ أَنَّهُ يَكْثَرُهُ كَلَامِهِمْ يُسْتَجَابُ لَهُمْ. ⁸فَلَا تَتَّبِعْهُوا بِهِمْ، لَأَنَّ أَبَاكُمْ يَعْلَمُ مَا تَخْتَاجُونَ إِلَيْهِ قَبْلَ أَنْ تَسْأَلُوهُ.

¹⁶وَمَتَى صُمَّمْتُمْ فَلَا تَكُونُوا عَائِسِينَ كَالْمُرَائِينَ، فَإِنَّهُمْ يُغَيِّرُونَ وُجُوهَهُمْ لِكَيْ يَظْهَرُوا لِلنَّاسِ صَائِمِينَ. الْحَقُّ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ: إِنَّهُمْ قَدْ اسْتَوْفَوْا أَجْرَهُمْ. ¹⁷وَأَمَّا أَنْتَ فَمَتَى صُمَّمْتَ فَادْهِنْ رَأْسَكَ وَاغْسِلْ وَجْهَكَ، لِكَيْ لَا يَظْهَرَ لِلنَّاسِ صَائِمًا بَلْ لِأَبِيكَ الَّذِي فِي الْخَفَاءِ، فَأَبُوكَ الَّذِي بَرَى فِي الْخَفَاءِ يُجَارِيكَ عِلَاقِيَّةً.

¹⁹لَا تَكْبُرُوا لَكُمْ كُنُوزًا عَلَى الْأَرْضِ حَيْثُ يُفْسِدُ السُّوسُ وَالصَّدَا وَحَيْثُ يَنْفَبُ السَّارِقُونَ وَيَسْرِقُونَ. ²⁰بَلْ اكْبُرُوا لَكُمْ كُنُوزًا فِي السَّمَاءِ حَيْثُ لَا يُفْسِدُ سُّوسٌ وَلَا صَدَا

¹Take heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven. ²Therefore when thou doest thine alms, do not sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. ³But when thou doest alms, let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth: ⁴That thine alms may be in secret: and thy Father which seeth in secret himself shall reward thee openly. ⁵And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. ⁶But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly. ⁷But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. ⁸Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him. ⁹After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. ¹⁰Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. ¹¹Give us this day our daily bread. ¹²And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. ¹³And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. ¹⁴For if ye forgive men their

وَحَيْثُ لَا يَتَّقِبُ سَارِقُونَ وَلَا يَسْرِقُونَ.²¹ لَأَنَّهُ حَيْثُ يَكُونُ كَنْزُكَ هُنَاكَ يَكُونُ قَلْبُكَ أَيْضًا.²² سِرَاجُ الْجَسَدِ هُوَ الْعَيْنُ، فَإِنْ كَانَتْ عَيْنُكَ تَسْبِيحَةً فَجَسَدُكَ كُلُّهُ يَكُونُ نَهْرًا.²³ وَإِنْ كَانَتْ عَيْنُكَ شَرِيرَةً فَجَسَدُكَ كُلُّهُ يَكُونُ مُظْلِمًا. فَإِنْ كَانَ النُّورُ الَّذِي فِيكَ ظُلَامًا قَالِ الظُّلَامُ كَمْ يَكُونُ.²⁴ لَا يَقْدِرُ أَحَدٌ أَنْ يَخْدِمَ سَيِّدَيْنِ، لَأَنَّهُ إِمَّا أَنْ يَبْغِضَ الْوَاحِدَ وَيُحِبَّ الْآخَرَ أَوْ يُلَازِمَ الْوَاحِدَ وَيَجْتَفِرَ الْآخَرَ، لَا تَقْدِرُونَ أَنْ تَعْدُمُوا اللَّهَ وَالنَّاسَ. لِذَلِكَ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ: لَا تَهْتَمُّوا لِحَيَاتِكُمْ بِمَا تَأْكُلُونَ وَبِمَا تَشْرَبُونَ، وَلَا لَجَسَدِكُمْ بِمَا تَلْبَسُونَ. أَلَيْسَتْ الْحَيَاةُ أَفْضَلَ مِنَ الطَّعَامِ وَالْجَسَدِ أَفْضَلَ مِنَ اللِّبَاسِ؟²⁵ أَنْظَرُوا إِلَى طُيُورِ السَّمَاءِ، إِنَّهَا لَا تَزْرَعُ وَلَا تَحْصُدُ وَلَا تَجْمَعُ إِلَى مَخَارِنَ، وَأَبُوكُمُ السَّمَاوِيُّ يَقُوُّهَا. أَلَيْسَ أَنْتُمْ بِالْحَرِيِّ أَفْضَلَ مِنْهَا؟²⁶ وَمَنْ مِنْكُمْ إِذَا اهْتَمَّ يَقْدِرُ أَنْ يَزِيدَ عَلَى قَامَتِهِ ذِرَاعًا وَاحِدَةً؟²⁷ وَلِمَاذَا تَهْتَمُّونَ بِاللِّبَاسِ؟ تَأْمَلُوا زَيْتُونِ الْحَقْلِ كَيْفَ تَتَمُّو، لَا تَعْبُ وَلَا تَغْزُلُ،²⁸ وَلَكِنْ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ: إِنَّهُ وَلَا سُلَيْمَانُ فِي كُلِّ مَخْدِهِ كَانَ يَلْبَسُ كَوَاجِدَةٍ مِنْهَا.²⁹ فَإِنْ كَانَ غُشْبُ الْحَقْلِ الَّذِي يُوجَدُ الْيَوْمَ وَيُطْرَحُ غَدًا فِي النَّوْرِ يُلْبِسُهُ اللَّهُ هَكَذَا، أَفَلَيْسَ بِالْحَرِيِّ جِدًّا يُلْبِسُكُمْ أَنْتُمْ، يَا قَلِيلِي الْإِيمَانِ؟³⁰ فَلَا تَهْتَمُّوا قَائِلِينَ: مَاذَا نَأْكُلُ؟ أَوْ مَاذَا نَشْرَبُ؟ أَوْ مَاذَا نَلْبَسُ؟³¹ فَإِنَّ هَذِهِ كُلَّهَا تَطْلُبُهَا الْأُمَمُ، لِأَنَّ آبَاكُمْ السَّمَاوِيِّ يَعْلَمُ أَنَّكُمْ تَحْتَاجُونَ إِلَى هَذِهِ كُلِّهَا.³² لَكِنْ اطْلُبُوا أَوَّلًا مَلَكُوتَ اللَّهِ وَبِرَّهُ وَهَذِهِ كُلُّهَا تُرَادُّ لَكُمْ.³³ فَلَا تَهْتَمُّوا لِلْغَدِ، لَأَنَّ الْعَدَّ يَهْتَمُّ بِمَا لِنَفْسِهِ، يَكْفِي الْيَوْمَ شَرُّهُ.³⁴

trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:¹⁵ But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.¹⁶ Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.¹⁷ But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face;¹⁸ That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.¹⁹ Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:²⁰ But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:²¹ For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.²² The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.²³ But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!²⁴ No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.²⁵ Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?²⁶ Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor

gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?²⁷ Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?²⁸ And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:²⁹ And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.³⁰ Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?³¹ Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?³² (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.³³ But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.³⁴ Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.
