الْجَلْجَالِ لِيَتَّعَرَفَ إِجَادَةَ الرَّبِّ.⁶بِمَ أَتَقَدَّمُ إِلَى الرَّبِّ
وَأُنْخِي لِلإِلَهِ الْعَلِيِّ. هَلْ أَتَقَدَّمُ بِمُحْرَقَاتٍ، بِعُجُولِ أَتْيَاءِ
سَتِّهِ.⁷هَلْ يُسَرُّ الرَّبُّ بِالْوَفِ الْكِتَاشِ، بِرَبَوَاتِ أَنْهَارِ
رَبَّتِ. هَلْ أُعْطِيَ بِكَرِي عَنْ مَعْصِيَتِي، ثَمَرَةَ جَسَدِي عَنْ
خَطِيئَةٍ تَفْسِي. ⁸قَدْ أَخْبَرَكِ أَنَّهَا الْإِنْسَانُ مَا هُوَ صَالِحٌ،
وَمَاذَا يَطْلُبُهُ مِنْكَ الرَّبُّ، إِلَّا أَنْ تَصْنَعَ الْحَقَّ وَتُحِبَّ
الرَّحْمَةَ، وَتَسْلُكَ مُتَوَاضِعًا مَعَ إِلَهِكَ.⁹صَوْتُ الرَّبِّ يُنَادِي
لِلْمَدِينَةِ، وَالْحِكْمَةُ تَرَى اسْمَكَ، إِسْمَعُوا لِلْقَضِيبِ وَمَنْ
رَسَمَهُ.¹⁰أَفِي بَيْتِ الشَّرِّيرِ بَعْدُ كُنُوزُ شَرٍّ وَإِبَقُهُ تَافِصُهُ
مَلْعُونَةٌ.¹¹هَلْ أَتَرَكِي مَعَ مَوَازِينِ الشَّرِّ وَمَعَ كَيْسِ مَعَايِيرِ
الْعِشِّ.¹²فَإِنَّ أَعْيَاءَهَا مَلَانُونَ ظُلْمًا، وَسُكَّانُهَا يَتَكَلَّمُونَ
بِالْكَذِبِ، وَلِسَانُهُمْ فِي فَمِهِمْ غَاشٌّ.¹³فَأَنَا قَدْ جَعَلْتُ
جُذُوحَكَ عَدِيمَةَ السَّقَاءِ، مُحْرَبًا مِنْ أَجْلِ خَطَايَاكَ.¹⁴أَنْتَ
تَأْكُلُ وَلَا تَشْبَعُ، وَجُوعُكَ فِي جَوْفِكَ. وَتُعْزَلُ وَلَا تُنْجِي،
وَالَّذِي تُنْجِيهِ أَدْفَعُهُ إِلَى السَّيْفِ.¹⁵أَنْتَ تَزْرَعُ وَلَا تَحْصُدُ.
أَنْتَ تَدُوسُ زَيْتُونًا وَلَا تَدْهِنُ يَرْبَتِ، وَسَلَاقَةً وَلَا تَشْرَبُ
خَمْرًا.¹⁶وَتُحْقِطُ فَرَائِضَ عُمْرِي وَجَمِيعَ أَعْمَالِ بَيْتِ أَجَابَ
وَتَسْلُكُونَ بِمَشُورَاتِهِمْ، لِكَيْ أَسْلَمَكَ لِلْحَرَابِ، وَسُكَّانُهَا
لِلصَّفِيرِ، فَتَحْمِلُونَ عَارَ سَعْيِي.

¹Hear ye now what the LORD saith; Arise, contend thou before the mountains, and let the hills hear thy voice.²Hear ye, O mountains, the LORD's controversy, and ye strong foundations of the earth: for the LORD hath a controversy with his people, and he will plead with Israel.³O my people, what have I done unto thee? and wherein have I wearied thee? testify against me.⁴For I brought thee up out of the land of Egypt, and redeemed thee out of the house of servants; and I sent before thee Moses, Aaron, and Miriam.⁵O my people, remember now what Balak king of Moab consulted, and what Balaam the son of Beor answered him from Shittim unto Gilgal; that ye may know the righteousness of the LORD.⁶Wherewith shall I come before the LORD, and bow myself before the high God? shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves of a year old?⁷Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, or with ten thousands of rivers of oil? shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?⁸He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?⁹The LORD's voice crieth unto the city, and the man of wisdom shall see thy name: hear ye the rod, and who hath appointed it.¹⁰Are there yet the treasures of wickedness in the house of the wicked, and the scant measure that is abominable?¹¹Shall I count them pure with the wicked balances, and with the bag of deceitful weights?¹²For the rich men thereof are full of violence, and the

inhabitants thereof have spoken lies, and their tongue is deceitful in their mouth.¹³ Therefore also will I make thee sick in smiting thee, in making thee desolate because of thy sins.¹⁴ Thou shalt eat, but not be satisfied; and thy casting down shall be in the midst of thee; and thou shalt take hold, but shalt not deliver; and that which thou deliverest will I give up to the sword.¹⁵ Thou shalt sow, but thou shalt not reap; thou shalt tread the olives, but thou shalt not anoint thee with oil; and sweet wine, but shalt not drink wine.¹⁶ For the statutes of Omri are kept, and all the works of the house of Ahab, and ye walk in their counsels; that I should make thee a desolation, and the inhabitants thereof an hissing: therefore ye shall bear the reproach of my people.
