هَهُنَا أَسْكُنُ لِأَنِّي اسْتَهَيْتُهَا.¹⁵طَعَامَهَا أَبَارِكْ بَرَكَهَ،
مَسَاكِينَهَا أَشْبِعْ خُبْرًا.¹⁶كَهَنَتَهَا أَلْبَسْ خَلَاصًا، وَأَتَقِيَاؤَهَا
