<sup>1</sup>To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David. Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him cometh my salvation.<sup>2</sup> He only is my rock and my salvation; he is my defence; I shall not be greatly moved.<sup>3</sup> How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall shall ye be, and as a tottering fence.<sup>4</sup> They only consult to cast him down from his excellency: they delight in lies: they bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. Selah.<sup>5</sup> My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him.<sup>6</sup> He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved.<sup>7</sup> In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God.<sup>8</sup> Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah.<sup>9</sup> Surely men of low degree are vanity, and men of high degree are a lie: to be laid in the balance, they are altogether lighter than vanity.<sup>10</sup> Trust not in oppression, and become not vain in robbery: if riches increase, set not your heart upon them.<sup>11</sup> God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power belongeth unto God.<sup>12</sup> Also unto thee, O Lord, belongeth mercy: for thou renderest to every man according to his work.
