عُشْباً فِي الْحَقْلِ.² لِأَنَّ التَّرَافِيمَ قَدْ تَكَلَّمُوا بِالْبَاطِلِ
وَالْعَرَّافِينَ رَأَوْا الْكَذِبَ وَأَحْبَرُوا بِالْخَلَامِ كَذِبٍ. يُعْزُّونَ
بِالْبَاطِلِ. لِذَلِكَ رَحَلُوا كَعَتَمٍ. ذَلُّوا إِذْ لَيْسَ رَاعٍ.³ عَلَى
الرُّعَاةِ اشْتَعَلَ عَصِيي فَعَاقَبْتُ الْأَعْنَدَةَ. لِأَنَّ رَبَّ الْجُنُودِ
قَدْ تَعَهَّدَ قَطِيعَهُ بَيْتَ يَهُودَا، وَجَعَلَهُمْ كَقَرَسٍ جَلَالِهِ فِي
الْقِتَالِ.⁴ مِنْهُ الرَّاوِيَةُ. مِنْهُ الْوَيْدُ. مِنْهُ قَوْسُ الْقِتَالِ. مِنْهُ
يَخْرُجُ كُلُّ طَالِمٍ جَمِيعاً.⁵ وَيَكُونُونَ كَالْجَبَابِرَةِ الدَّائِسِينَ
طِينِ الْأَسْوَاقِ فِي الْقِتَالِ، وَيُحَارِبُونَ لِأَنَّ الرَّبَّ مَعَهُمْ،
وَالرَّاكِبُونَ الْجَيْلِ يَخْزُونَ.⁶ وَأَقْوَى بَيْتَ يَهُودَا وَأَخْلَصُ
بَيْتَ يُوْسُفَ وَأَرْجِعُهُمْ، لِأَنِّي قَدْ رَجَمْتُهُمْ. وَيَكُونُونَ كَأَنِّي
لَمْ أَرْفُضْهُمْ، لِأَنِّي أَنَا الرَّبُّ إِلَهُهُمْ فَأَجِيبُهُمْ.⁷ وَيَكُونُ
أَفْرَائِمُ كَجَبَّارٍ، وَيَفْرَحُ قَلْبُهُمْ كَأَنَّهُ بِالْحَمْرِ، وَيَنْظُرُ بَنُوهُمْ
فَيَفْرَحُونَ وَيَبْتَهِجُ قَلْبُهُمْ يَالرَّبِّ.⁸ أَصْفِرُ لَهُمْ وَأَجْمَعُهُمْ
لِأَنِّي قَدْ قَدَيْتُهُمْ، وَيَكْتُمُونَ كَمَا كَتَمُوا.⁹ وَأَزْرَعُهُمْ بَيْنَ
السُّعُوبِ فَيَذْكُرُونَنِي فِي الْأَرْضِ الْبَعِيدَةِ، وَيَخْتَبِرُونَ مَعَ
بَنِيهِمْ وَيَرْجِعُونَ.¹⁰ وَأَرْجِعُهُمْ مِنْ أَرْضِ مِصْرَ وَأَجْمَعُهُمْ
مِنْ أَشُورَ وَأَتِي بِهِمْ إِلَى أَرْضِ جِلْعَادَ وَلَبْنَانَ، وَلَا يُوْجَدُ
لَهُمْ مَكَانٌ.¹¹ وَيَعْبُرُ فِي بَحْرِ الصَّيْقِ، وَيَصْرُبُ اللَّحْجَ فِي
الْبَحْرِ، وَتَجِفُّ كُلُّ أَعْمَاقِ النَّهْرِ، وَتُخَفَضُ كِبْرَاءَةُ أَشُورَ،
وَيَرْوُلُ قَصِيبُ مِصْرَ.¹² وَأَقْوِيَهُمْ بِالرَّبِّ فَيَسْلُكُونَ بِاسْمِهِ
يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ.

¹Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.²For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd.³Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.⁴Out of him came forth the corner, out of him the nail, out of him the battle bow, out of him every oppressor together.⁵And they shall be as mighty men, which tread down their enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD is with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.⁶And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I am the LORD their God, and will hear them.⁷And they of Ephraim shall be like a mighty man, and their heart shall rejoice as through wine: yea, their children shall see it, and be glad; their heart shall rejoice in the LORD.⁸I will hiss for them, and gather them; for I have redeemed them: and they shall increase as they have increased.⁹And I will sow them among the people: and they shall remember me in far countries; and they shall live with their children, and turn again.¹⁰I will bring them again also out of the land of Egypt, and

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gather them out of Assyria; and I will bring them into the land of Gilead and Lebanon; and place shall not be found for them.¹¹ And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away.¹² And I will strengthen them in the LORD; and they shall walk up and down in his name, saith the LORD.
