

## Psalms 130

<sup>1</sup>A Song of degrees. Out of the depths have I cried unto thee, O LORD.<sup>2</sup>Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications.<sup>3</sup>If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand?<sup>4</sup>But there is forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared.<sup>5</sup>I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.<sup>6</sup>My soul waiteth for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning.<sup>7</sup>Let Israel hope in the LORD: for with the LORD there is mercy, and with him is plenteous redemption.<sup>8</sup>And he shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities.
