¹Call now, if there be any that will answer thee; and to which of the saints wilt thou turn?²For wrath killeth the foolish man, and envy slayeth the silly one. I have seen the foolish taking root: but suddenly I cursed his habitation.⁴His children are far from safety, and they are crushed in the gate, neither is there any to deliver them.⁵Whose harvest the hungry eateth up, and taketh it even out of the thorns, and the robber swalloweth up their substance.⁶Although affliction cometh not forth of the dust, neither doth trouble spring out of the ground;⁷Yet man is born unto trouble, as the sparks fly upward.⁸I would seek unto God, and unto God would I commit my cause:⁹Which doeth great things and unsearchable; marvellous things without number:¹⁰Who giveth rain upon the earth, and sendeth waters upon the fields:¹¹To set up on high those that be low; that those which mourn may be exalted to safety.¹²He disappointeth the devices of the crafty, so that their hands cannot perform their enterprise.¹³He taketh the wise in their own craftiness: and the counsel of the froward is carried headlong.¹⁴They meet with darkness in the daytime, and grope in the noonday as in the night.¹⁵But he saveth the poor from the sword, from their mouth, and from the hand of the mighty.¹⁶So the poor hath hope, and iniquity stoppeth her mouth.¹⁷Behold, happy is the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty:¹⁸For he maketh sore, and bindeth up: he woundeth, and his hands make whole.¹⁹He
