 وَصَايَايَ.² فَإِنَّهَا تَزِيدُكَ طُولَ أَيَّامٍ، وَسِينِي حَيَاةٍ
 وَسَلَامَةً.³ لَا تَدَعِ الرَّحْمَةَ وَالْحَقَّ يَتْرُكَانِكَ. تَقْلَدُهُمَا عَلَى
 عُنُقِكَ. أَكْبُثُهُمَا عَلَى لَوْحِ قَلْبِكَ،⁴ فَتَجِدَ نِعْمَةً وَفِطْنَةً
 صَالِحَةً فِي أَعْيُنِ اللَّهِ وَالنَّاسِ.⁵ تَوَكَّلْ عَلَى الرَّبِّ يَكُلُّ
 قَلْبُكَ، وَعَلَى فَهْمِكَ لَا تَعْتَمِدْ.⁶ فِي كُلِّ طَرَفِكَ اعْرِفْهُ
 وَهُوَ يُقَوِّمُ سُبْلَكَ.⁷ لَا تَكُنْ حَكِيمًا فِي عَيْنَيْ تَفْسِكَ. اتَّقِ
 الرَّبَّ وَابْعُدْ عَنِ الشَّرِّ،⁸ فَيَكُونُ شِقَاءً لِسِرَّتِكَ، وَسَقَاءً
 لِعِظَامِكَ.⁹ أَكْرِمِ الرَّبَّ مِنْ مَالِكَ وَمِنْ كُلِّ بَاكُورَاتِ
 غَلَّتِكَ،¹⁰ فَتَمْتَلِئَ خَزَائِنُكَ شَبْعًا وَتَفِيضَ مَعَاصِرُكَ
 مِسْطَارًا.¹¹ يَا ابْنِي، لَا تَحْقِرْ تَأْدِيبَ الرَّبِّ وَلَا تَكْرَهُ
 تَوْبِيخَهُ،¹² لِأَنَّ الَّذِي يُحِبُّهُ الرَّبُّ يُؤَدِّبُهُ، وَكَأَبِ يَابَنِ يُسَرُّ
 بِهِ.¹³ طُوبَى لِلإِنْسَانِ الَّذِي يَجِدُ الْحِكْمَةَ، وَلِلرَّجُلِ الَّذِي
 يَتَأَلَّفُهُمْ،¹⁴ لِأَنَّ تِجَارَتَهَا خَيْرٌ مِنْ تِجَارَةِ الْفِصَّةِ، وَرِنَحِهَا
 خَيْرٌ مِنَ الذَّهَبِ الْخَالِصِ.¹⁵ هِيَ أَثْمَنُ مِنَ اللَّائِي وَكُلِّ
 جَوَاهِرِكَ لَا تُسَاوِيهَا.¹⁶ فِي يَمِينِهَا طُولُ أَيَّامٍ، وَفِي
 يَسَارِهَا الْعِزُّ وَالْمَجْدُ.¹⁷ طُرْفُهَا طُرُقُ نِعَمٍ، وَكُلِّ
 مَسَالِكِهَا سَلَامٌ.¹⁸ هِيَ شَجَرَةُ حَيَاةٍ لِمُسْكِيهَا،
 وَالْمُتَمَسِّكُ بِهَا مَغْبُوطٌ.¹⁹ الرَّبُّ بِالْحِكْمَةِ أَهْبَسَ الْأَرْضَ.
 أَثْبَتَ السَّمَاوَاتِ بِالْفَهْمِ.²⁰ يَعْلَمُهُ انْشَقَّتِ اللَّجَجُ وَتَفْطُرُ
 السَّحَابُ نَدًى.²¹ يَا ابْنِي، لَا تَبْرُحْ هَذِهِ مِنْ عَيْنِكَ. اخْفَظْ
 الرَّأْيَ وَالتَّذْيِيرَ فَيَكُونَا حَيَاةً لِنَفْسِكَ، وَنِعْمَةً
 لِعُنُقِكَ.²² حِينَئِذٍ تَسْلُكُ فِي طَرِيقِكَ أَمِنًا، وَلَا تَعْثُرُ
 رِجْلُكَ.²³ إِذَا اضْطَجَعْتَ فَلَا تَخَافْ بَلْ تَضْطَجِعْ وَتَلِدْ
 نَوْمًا.²⁴ لَا تَحْشَى مِنْ خَوْفٍ بَاغِتٍ، وَلَا مِنْ خَرَابِ
 الْأَشْرَارِ إِذَا جَاءَ.²⁵ لِأَنَّ الرَّبَّ يَكُونُ مُعْتَمِدَكَ، وَيَصُونُ
 رِجْلَكَ مِنْ أَنْ تُؤْخَذَ.²⁶ لَا تَمْنَعْ الْخَيْرَ عَنْ أَهْلِهِ حِينَ يَكُونُ
 فِي طَاقَةٍ يَدِكَ أَنْ تَفْعَلَهُ.²⁷ لَا تَقُلْ لِصَاحِبِكَ، اذْهَبْ وَعُدْ
 فَأَعْطِيكَ عَدَاً وَمَوْجُودَ عِنْدَكَ.²⁸ لَا تَحْتَرِغْ سِرًّا عَلَى
 صَاحِبِكَ وَهُوَ سَاكِنٌ لَدَيْكَ أَمِنًا.²⁹ لَا تُخَاصِمِ إِنْسَانًا يَذُونُ
 سَبَبَ، إِنْ لَمْ يَكُنْ قَدْ صَنَعَ مَعَكَ سِرًّا.³⁰ لَا تُخْسِدِ الطَّالِمَ
 وَلَا تَحْتَرِ شَيْئًا مِنْ طَرَفِهِ،³¹ لِأَنَّ الْمُتَلَوِّي رَجْسٌ عِنْدَ
 الرَّبِّ. أَمَّا سِرُّهُ فَعِنْدَ الْمُسْتَفِيمِينَ.³² لَعْنَةُ الرَّبِّ فِي بَيْتِ
 السَّرِيرِ لِكِنَّةِ يُبَارِكُ مَسْكَنَ الصَّادِقِينَ.³³ كَمَا أَنَّهُ يَسْتَهْزِئُ
 بِالْمُسْتَهْزِئِينَ هَكَذَا يُعْطِي نِعْمَةً لِلْمُتَوَاضِعِينَ.³⁴ الْحُكَمَاءُ
 يَرْتَوْنَ مَجْدًا وَالْحَمَمَى يَحْمِلُونَ هَوَانًا.³⁵

¹My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments.²For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.³Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart.⁴So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.⁵Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.⁶In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.⁷Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.⁸It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.⁹Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase.¹⁰So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.¹¹My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction.¹²For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.¹³Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.¹⁴For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold.¹⁵She is more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her.¹⁶Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour.¹⁷Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace.¹⁸She is a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy is every one that retaineth her.¹⁹The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath

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he established the heavens.²⁰ By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew.²¹ My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion:²² So shall they be life unto thy soul, and grace to thy neck.²³ Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble.²⁴ When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.²⁵ Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it cometh.²⁶ For the LORD shall be thy confidence, and shall keep thy foot from being taken.²⁷ Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of thine hand to do it .²⁸ Say not unto thy neighbour, Go, and come again, and to morrow I will give; when thou hast it by thee.²⁹ Devise not evil against thy neighbour, seeing he dwelleth securely by thee.³⁰ Strive not with a man without cause, if he have done thee no harm.³¹ Envy thou not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways.³² For the froward is abomination to the LORD: but his secret is with the righteous.³³ The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the just.³⁴ Surely he scorneth the scorners: but he giveth grace unto the lowly.³⁵ The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools.
