<sup>1</sup> يَا رَبُّ، إِلَيْكَ صَرَخْتُ، أَسْرِعْ إِلَيَّ، أَصْغِ إِلَى صَوْتِي عِنْدَ مَا أَصْرَحُ إِلَيْكَ. <sup>2</sup> لِيَسْتَقِمَّ صَلَاتِي كَالْبُخُورِ قُدَّامَكَ، لِيَكُنْ رَفْعُ يَدَيَّ كَذَبِيحَةِ مَسَائِيَّةٍ. <sup>3</sup> اجْعَلْ، يَا رَبُّ، خَارِسًا لِقَمِي، احْفَظْ بَابَ شَفَتِي. <sup>4</sup> لَا تُمِلْ قَلْبِي إِلَى أَمْرِ رِدِيٍّ لِأَتَعَلَّلَ بِعِلَلِ الشَّرِّ مَعَ أَتَاسٍ قَاعِلِي إِيَّامٍ وَلَا أَكُلُ مِنْ ثَقَائِبِهِمْ. <sup>5</sup> لِيَصْرِئَنِي الصَّدِيقُ قَرَحَمَةً، وَلِيُوْتِحَنِي قَرِيبُ الرِّأْسِ، لَا يَأْتِيَ رَأْسِي. <sup>6</sup> لِأَنَّ صَلَاتِي بَعْدَ فِي مَصَائِبِهِمْ. قَدْ انْطَرَحَ قُضَائِهِمْ مِنْ عَلَى الصَّخْرَةِ وَسَمِعُوا كَلِمَاتِي لِأَنَّهَا لَذِيذَةٌ. <sup>7</sup> كَمَنْ يَفْلَحُ وَيَشْقُ الْأَرْضَ تَبَدَّدَتْ عِظَامُنَا عِنْدَ قَمِ الْهَاوِيَةِ. <sup>8</sup> لِأَنَّهُ إِلَيْكَ، يَا سَيِّدُ، يَا رَبُّ، عَيْتَانِي. بِكَ اخْتَمَيْتُ، لَا تُفْرِغْ نَفْسِي. <sup>9</sup> احْفَظْنِي مِنَ الْفَحِّ الَّذِي قَدْ تَصْبُوهُ لِي، وَمِنْ أَشْرَاكِ قَاعِلِي الْإِيَّامِ. <sup>10</sup> لِيَسْقُطِ الْأَشْرَارُ فِي شِبَاكِهِمْ حَتَّى أَنْجُو أَنَا بِالْكَلِيَّةِ.

LORD, I cry unto thee: make haste unto me; give ear unto my voice, when I cry unto thee. <sup>2</sup> Let my prayer be set forth before thee as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice. <sup>3</sup> Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips. <sup>4</sup> Incline not my heart to any evil thing, to practise wicked works with men that work iniquity: and let me not eat of their dainties. <sup>5</sup> Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also shall be in their calamities. <sup>6</sup> When their judges are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear my words; for they are sweet. <sup>7</sup> Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth wood upon the earth. <sup>8</sup> But mine eyes are unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute. <sup>9</sup> Keep me from the snares which they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity. <sup>10</sup> Let the wicked fall into their own nets, whilst that I withal escape.
