<sup>7</sup>فَيَرْمِيهِمُ اللَّهُ بِسَهْمٍ، بَعْتَهُ كَانَتْ صَرْبَتُهُمْ. <sup>8</sup>وَيُوقِعُونَ أَلْسِنَتَهُمْ عَلَى أَنْفُسِهِمْ، يُبْغِضُ الرَّأْسَ كُلُّ مَنْ يَنْظُرُ إِلَيْهِمْ. <sup>9</sup>وَيَخْشَى كُلُّ إِنْسَانٍ وَيُخِيرُ بِفِعْلِ اللَّهِ وَيَعْمَلُهُ يَفْطِنُونَ. <sup>10</sup>يَفْرَحُ الصَّادِقُ بِالرَّبِّ وَبَحْتِمِي بِهِ وَيَبْتَهِجُ كُلُّ الْمُسْتَقِيمِ الْقُلُوبِ.

Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. <sup>2</sup>Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity: <sup>3</sup>Who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words: <sup>4</sup>That they may shoot in secret at the perfect: suddenly do they shoot at him, and fear not. <sup>5</sup>They encourage themselves in an evil matter: they commune of laying snares privily; they say, Who shall see them? <sup>6</sup>They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them, and the heart, is deep. <sup>7</sup>But God shall shoot at them with an arrow; suddenly shall they be wounded. <sup>8</sup>So they shall make their own tongue to fall upon themselves: all that see them shall flee away. <sup>9</sup>And all men shall fear, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of his doing. <sup>10</sup>The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.
