<sup>1</sup>اللَّهُمَّ، لَا تَضُمَّتْ. لَا تَسْكُتْ وَلَا تَهْدَأْ، يَا إِلَهَهُ. <sup>2</sup>فَهُودَا  
أَعْدَاؤُكَ يَعْجُونَ وَمُبْعِضُونَ قَدْ رَفَعُوا الرُّأْسَ. <sup>3</sup>عَلَى  
سَعْيِكَ مَكَرُوا مُؤَامَرَةً وَتَسَاوَرُوا عَلَى  
أَحْمِيائِكَ. <sup>4</sup>قَالُوا: <sup>4</sup>هَلُمَّ يُبْذِهِمْ مِنْ بَيْنِ الشُّعُوبِ وَلَا يُدْكِرْ  
اسْمُ إِسْرَائِيلَ بَعْدُ. <sup>5</sup>لَا تَنْهَمُ تَأْمُرُوا بِالْقَلْبِ مَعًا، عَلَيْكَ تَعَاهَدُوا عَهْدًا: <sup>6</sup>خِيَامُ  
أَدُومَ وَالْإِسْمَاعِيلِيِّينَ، مُوَابَ وَالْهَاجَرِيِّينَ، <sup>7</sup>جِبَالُ وَعَمُّونَ  
وَعَمَالِيْقَ، فِلِسْطِينَ مَعَ سُكَّانِ صُورَ. <sup>8</sup>أَشُورَ أَيْضًا اتَّقَى  
مَعَهُمْ، صَارُوا ذِرَاعًا لِبَنِي لُوطَ. سِلَاهُ <sup>9</sup>إِفْعَلْ بِهِمْ كَمَا بِمِذْبَانَ، كَمَا بِسِيسَرَ، كَمَا بِبَايِينَ فِي  
وَادِي قَيْشُونَ. <sup>10</sup>بَادُوا فِي عَيْنِ دُورَ، صَارُوا دِمْنًا  
لِلْأَرْضِ. <sup>11</sup>اجْعَلْ شُرَقَاءَهُمْ مِثْلَ غُرَابٍ وَمِثْلَ ذَنْبٍ، وَمِثْلَ  
رَبِّحٍ وَمِثْلَ صُلْمَتَاعَ كُلِّ أَمْرَانِهِمْ. <sup>12</sup>الَّذِينَ قَالُوا: لِنَمْلِكُ  
لِأَنْفُسِنَا مَسَاكِينَ لِلَّهِ. <sup>13</sup>يَا إِلَهِي، اجْعَلْهُمْ مِثْلَ الْجُلِّ، مِثْلَ الْقَشِّ أَمَامَ  
الرَّيْحِ. <sup>14</sup>كَتَارَ تُحْرِقُ الْوَعَرَ، كُلَّهَيْبٍ يُسْعِلُ الْجِبَالَ. <sup>15</sup>هَكَذَا  
اطْرَدَهُمْ بِعَاصِفِكَ، وَبِرَوْعِكَ رَوَّعَهُمْ. <sup>16</sup>أَمْلَأْ وُجُوهَهُمْ  
خِزْيًا قَبِطْلُبُوا اسْمَكَ، يَا رَبِّ. <sup>17</sup>لِيَخْرُوا وَيَرْتَاغُوا إِلَى  
الْأَبَدِ، وَلِيَجْلُوا وَيَبِيدُوا، <sup>18</sup>وَيَعْلَمُوا أَنَّكَ اسْمُكَ يَهْوُهُ  
وَحَدَكَ، الْعَلِيِّ عَلَى كُلِّ الْأَرْضِ.

<sup>1</sup>A Song or Psalm of Asaph. Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God. <sup>2</sup>For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head. <sup>3</sup>They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones. <sup>4</sup>They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance. <sup>5</sup>For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee: <sup>6</sup>The tabernacles of Edom, and the Ishmaelites; of Moab, and the Hagarenes; <sup>7</sup>Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre; <sup>8</sup>Assur also is joined with them: they have holpen the children of Lot. Selah. <sup>9</sup>Do unto them as unto the Midianites; as to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook of Kison: <sup>10</sup>Which perished at Endor: they became as dung for the earth. <sup>11</sup>Make their nobles like Oreb, and like Zeeb: yea, all their princes as Zebah, and as Zalmunna: <sup>12</sup>Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession. <sup>13</sup>O my God, make them like a wheel; as the stubble before the wind. <sup>14</sup>As the fire burneth a wood, and as the flame setteth the mountains on fire; <sup>15</sup>So persecute them with thy tempest, and make them afraid with thy storm. <sup>16</sup>Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O LORD. <sup>17</sup>Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish: <sup>18</sup>That men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over

all the earth.
