

¹ فِي ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمِ يَكُونُ يَنْبُوعٌ مَفْتُوحًا لِيَبْتَ دَاوُدَ وَلِسَكَّانِ
 أَوْرَسَلِيمَ لِلْخَطِيئَةِ وَلِلنَّجَاسَةِ. ² وَيَكُونُ فِي ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمِ،
 يَقُولُ رَبُّ الْجُنُودِ، أَنِّي أَقْطَعُ أَسْمَاءَ الْأَصْنَامِ مِنَ الْأَرْضِ
 فَلَا تُذَكَّرُ بَعْدُ، وَأَزِيلُ الْأَنْبِيَاءَ أَيْضًا وَالرُّوحَ الْبَاجِسَ مِنَ
 الْأَرْضِ. ³ وَيَكُونُ إِذَا تَبَّأَ أَحَدٌ بَعْدَ أَبِي أَبِيهِ وَأُمِّهِ وَالِدَيْهِ
 يَقُولَانِ لَهُ، لَا تَعِيشْ لِأَنَّكَ تَكَلَّمْتَ بِالْكَذِبِ بِاسْمِ الرَّبِّ.
 فَتُطْعَمُهُ أَبُوهُ وَأُمُّهُ وَالِدَاهُ عِنْدَمَا يَتَبَّأُ. ⁴ وَيَكُونُ فِي ذَلِكَ
 الْيَوْمِ أَنَّ الْأَنْبِيَاءَ يَحْرَوْنَ كُلَّ وَاحِدٍ مِنْ رُؤُوسِهِ إِذَا تَبَّأَ، وَلَا
 يَلْبِسُونَ ثَوْبَ سَعَرٍ لِأَجْلِ الْغَيْشِ. ⁵ بَلْ يَقُولُ، لَسْتُ أَنَا
 نَبِيًّا. أَنَا إِنْسَانٌ قَالِحٌ الْأَرْضِ، لِأَنَّ إِنْسَانًا افْتَنَانِي مِنْ
 صِبَايَ. ⁶ فَيَسْأَلُهُ، مَا هَذِهِ الْجُرُوحُ فِي يَدَيْكَ. فَيَقُولُ، هِيَ
 الَّتِي جُرِحْتُ بِهَا فِي بَيْتِ أَجْبَائِي. ⁷ اسْتَيْقِظْ يَا سَيْفُ عَلَى
 رَأْعِي وَعَلَى رَجُلِ رَفِقَتِي، يَقُولُ رَبُّ الْجُنُودِ. إِصْرِبِ
 الرَّاعِي فَتَنْسَلَّتِ الْعَنَمُ، وَأَرْدُدْ يَدِي عَلَى الصَّعَارِ. ⁸ وَيَكُونُ
 فِي كُلِّ الْأَرْضِ يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ أَنِّي ثَلَثِينَ مِنْهَا يُقْطَعَانِ
 وَيَمُوتَانِ، وَالثَّلَاثُ يَبْقَى فِيهَا. ⁹ وَأَدْخِلِ الثَّلَاثَ فِي النَّارِ،
 وَأَمْحِضْهُمْ كَمْحَصِ الْفِصَّةِ، وَأَمْحِضْهُمْ أَمْحَاحَ الذَّهَبِ.
 هُوَ يَدْعُو بِاسْمِي وَأَنَا أَجِيبُهُ. أَقُولُ، هُوَ سَعْيِي وَهُوَ
 يَقُولُ، الرَّبُّ إِلَهِي.

¹ In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness. ² And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land. ³ And it shall come to pass, that when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say unto him, Thou shalt not live; for thou speakest lies in the name of the LORD: and his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he prophesieth. ⁴ And it shall come to pass in that day, that the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to deceive: ⁵ But he shall say, I am no prophet, I am an husbandman; for man taught me to keep cattle from my youth. ⁶ And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends. ⁷ Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones. ⁸ And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the LORD, two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left therein. ⁹ And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall

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call on my name, and I will hear them: I
will say, It is my people: and they shall say,
The LORD is my God.
