 قِيَاسٍ.<sup>2</sup>فَقُلْتُ، إِلَى أَيْنَ أَنْتَ ذَاهِبٌ. فَقَالَ لِي، لِأَفِيسَ  
 أُورُشَلِيمَ، لِأَرَى كَمْ عَرْضُهَا وَكَمْ طُولُهَا.<sup>3</sup>وَإِذَا بِالْمَلَكِ  
 الَّذِي كَلَّمَنِي قَدْ خَرَجَ، وَخَرَجَ مَلَكٌ آخَرٌ لِلِقَائِهِ.<sup>4</sup>فَقَالَ لَهُ،  
 اجْرُ وَقُلْ لِهَذَا الْعَلَامِ، كَالْأَعْرَاءِ تُسْكُنُ أُورُشَلِيمَ مِنْ  
 كَثَرَةِ النَّاسِ وَالتَّهَائِمِ فِيهَا.<sup>5</sup>وَأَنَا، يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ، أَكُونُ لَهَا  
 سُورَ تَارٍ مِنْ حَوْلِهَا، وَأَكُونُ مَجْدًا فِي وَسْطِهَا.<sup>6</sup>يَا يَا،  
 اهْرُبُوا مِنْ أَرْضِ الشَّمَالِ يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ. قَاتِي قَدْ قَرَرْتُكُمْ  
 كَرِيحَ السَّمَاءِ الْأَرْبَعِ، يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ.<sup>7</sup>تَسْجِي يَا صِهْيَوْنَ  
 السَّاكِنَةُ فِي بَيْتِ بَابِلَ،<sup>8</sup>لَأَنَّهُ هَكَذَا قَالَ رَبُّ الْجُنُودِ، بَعْدَ  
 الْمَجْدِ أُرْسَلَنِي إِلَى الْأُمَمِ الَّذِينَ سَلَبُوكُمْ، لَأَنَّهُ مَنْ  
 يَمَسُّكُمْ يَمَسُّ حَذَقَةَ عَيْنِي.<sup>9</sup>لَأَنِّي هُنَذَا أَحَرُّكُ يَدِي عَلَيْهِمْ  
 فَيَكُونُونَ سَلْبًا لِعَبِيدِهِمْ. فَتَعْلَمُونَ أَنَّ رَبَّ الْجُنُودِ قَدْ  
 أُرْسَلَنِي.<sup>10</sup>تَرْتَمِي وَافْرَجِي يَا بَيْتَ صِهْيَوْنَ، لَأَنِّي هُنَذَا  
 آتِي وَأَسْكُنُ فِي وَسْطِكَ، يَقُولُ الرَّبُّ.<sup>11</sup>فَيَبْصِلُ أُمَّمُ  
 كَثِيرَةٌ بِالرَّبِّ فِي ذَلِكَ الْيَوْمِ، وَيَكُونُونَ لِي شَعْبًا فَأَسْكُنُ  
 فِي وَسْطِكَ، فَتَعْلَمِينَ أَنَّ رَبَّ الْجُنُودِ قَدْ أُرْسَلَنِي  
 إِلَيْكُمْ.<sup>12</sup>وَالرَّبُّ يَرِثُ يَهُودًا تَصِيبُهُ فِي الْأَرْضِ الْمُقَدَّسَةِ  
 وَيَحْتَارُ أُورُشَلِيمَ بَعْدَ.<sup>13</sup>أَسْكُنُوا يَا كُلَّ الْبَشَرِ قُدَّامَ الرَّبِّ  
 لَأَنَّهُ قَدْ اسْتَيْقِظَ مِنْ مَسْكِنِ قُدْسِهِ.

out of his holy habitation.
