Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the mountain of his holiness.<sup>2</sup> Beautiful for situation, the joy of the whole earth, is mount Zion, on the sides of the north, the city of the great King.<sup>3</sup> God is known in her palaces for a refuge.<sup>4</sup> For, lo, the kings were assembled, they passed by together.<sup>5</sup> They saw it, and so they marvelled; they were troubled, and hasted away.<sup>6</sup> Fear took hold upon them there, and pain, as of a woman in travail.<sup>7</sup> Thou breakest the ships of Tarshish with an east wind.<sup>8</sup> As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the LORD of hosts, in the city of our God: God will establish it for ever.
