لِلْمَسِيئِينَ بِالْعَنَقِ، وَلِلْمَاسُورِينَ بِالْإِطْلَاقِ.² لِأُنَادِيَ بِسَبْتَةِ
مَقْبُولَةِ الرَّبِّ، وَبِیَوْمِ انْتِقَامٍ لِإِهْنَاءِ. لِأُعْزِّي كُلَّ
الْتَائِحِينَ.³ لِأَجْعَلَ لِتَائِحِي صِهْنُونَ، لِأُعْطِيَهُمْ جَمَالًا عِوَضًا
عَنِ الرَّمَادِ، وَذَهَبَ قَرَحَ عِوَضًا عَنِ النَّوْحِ، وَرِداءَ تَسْبِيحِ
عِوَضًا عَنِ الرُّوحِ الْبَائِسَةِ، فَيُذْعَوْنَ أَشْجَارُ الْبَرِّ، غَرْسَ
الرَّبِّ لِلتَّمْجِيدِ.⁴ وَيَسْتَوْنَ الْخَرِبُ الْقَدِيمَةُ. يُقِيمُونَ
الْمُوحِشَاتِ الْأَوَّلِ. وَيُجَدِّدُونَ الْمُدْنَ الْخَرِبَةَ، مُوحِشَاتِ
دَوْرِ قَدُورٍ.⁵ وَيَقِفُ الْأَجَائِبُ وَتَرْعَوْنَ عَنَمَكُمُ، وَيَكُونُ بَنُو
الْعَرِيبِ حَرَائِكُمْ وَكَرَامِكُمْ.⁶ أَمَّا أَنْتُمْ فَتُذْعَوْنَ كَهَنَةَ
الرَّبِّ، تُسَمَّوْنَ خُدَّامَ إِلَهِنَا. تَأْكُلُونَ تَرْوَةَ الْأَمَمِ، وَعَلَى
مَحْدِيهِمْ تَتَأَمَّرُونَ.⁷ عِوَضًا عَنْ خَرِبِكُمْ صَعْقَانِ، وَعِوَضًا
عَنِ الْحَجَلِ يَسْتَهْجُونَ بِتَصْبِيهِمْ. لِذَلِكَ يَرْتُونَ فِي أَرْضِهِمْ
صُعْقِينَ. بَهْجَةُ أَبَدِيَّةٍ تَكُونُ لَهُمْ.⁸ لِأَنِّي أَنَا الرَّبُّ مُجِبُّ
الْعَدْلِ، مُبْغِضُ الْمُخْتَلِسِ بِالظُّلْمِ. وَأَجْعَلَ أَجْرَهُمْ أَيْمَنَةً،
وَأَقْطَعُ لَهُمْ عَهْدًا أَبَدِيًّا.⁹ وَيُعْرِفُ بَيْنَ الْأَمَمِ تَسْلُهُمْ،
وَيُذَرِّبُهُمْ فِي وَسْطِ الشُّعُوبِ. كُلُّ الَّذِينَ يَرَوْنَهُمْ
يَعْرِفُونَهُمْ أَنَّهُمْ تَسْلُ بَارَكَةِ الرَّبِّ.¹⁰ قَرَحًا أَفْرَحُ بِالرَّبِّ.
تَسْبَحُ نَفْسِي بِالْإِلَهِ، لِأَنَّهُ قَدْ أَلْبَسَنِي ثِيَابَ الْخَلَاصِ.
كَسَانِي رِداءَ الْبَرِّ، مِثْلَ عَرِيسٍ يَتَرَبَّنُ بِعِمَامَةٍ، وَمِثْلَ
عَرُوسٍ تَتَرَبَّنُ بِخُلِيِّهَا.¹¹ لِأَنَّهُ كَمَا أَنَّ الْأَرْضَ تُخْرِجُ ثَبَاتَهَا،
وَكَمَا أَنَّ الْحَبَّةَ تُنْبِثُ مَرْوَعَاتِهَا، هَكَذَا السَّيِّدُ الرَّبُّ يُنْبِثُ
بِرًّا وَتَسْبِيحًا أَمَامَ كُلِّ الْأَمَمِ.

¹The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;²To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;³To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.⁴And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations.⁵And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.⁶But ye shall be named the Priests of the LORD: men shall call you the Ministers of our God: ye shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves.⁷For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.⁸For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.⁹And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed

which the LORD hath blessed.¹⁰ I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels.¹¹ For as the earth bringeth forth her bud, and as the garden causeth the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.
