- Row 4: 13 points (top-left, top-middle, top-right, top-bottom, middle-left, middle-right, bottom-left, bottom-right, middle-bottom, middle-top, middle-middle, middle-left, middle-right), 14 points (top-left, top-middle, top-right, top-bottom, middle-left, middle-right, bottom-left, bottom-right, middle-bottom, middle-top, middle-middle, middle-left, middle-right, middle-bottom), 15 points (top-left, top-middle, top-right, top-bottom, middle-left, middle-right, bottom-left, bottom-right, middle-bottom, middle-top, middle-middle, middle-left, middle-right, middle-bottom, middle-top), 16 points (top-left, top-middle, top-right, top-bottom, middle-left, middle-right, bottom-left, bottom-right, middle-bottom, middle-top, middle-middle, middle-left, middle-right, middle-bottom, middle-top, middle-middle).
